Cash to purchase the rain barrels through Oak Ridge Revitalization Effort is earmarked for water conservation efforts, according to Grove Center Merchants sustainability program.

- Artists submitting design proposals for the rain barrels *may be eligible* for a \$200 stipend upon completion of project.
- Design proposals must be received by October 28, 2011 for review. Artists may submit more than one proposal for possible approval. If approved, artists must submit the finished rain barrel by May 1, 2012.
- Requirements for artwork approval include exclusion of designs that are religious, political or sexual in nature, or use corporate logos, unless you are purchasing a Rain Barrel specifically for use at your business following the Rain Barrel Event.
- Using decorated rain barrels to raise awareness and encourage water conservation continues a Sustainability tradition of educational community outreach campaigns.
